


New Address Verification Process



As Belton ISD prepares to implement the new elementary school attendance boundaries and to ensure fidelity of our existing attendance boundaries at all levels, the district will begin a new address verification process this spring. Returning families with students going to the 3rd, 6th and 9th grades will be required to verify their home address during the enrollment verification process for the 2024-25 school year. Any students new to Belton ISD and incoming kindergarteners must also verify their home address. Online enrollment will open April 16.
