Then at 2 p.m., we will host a groundbreaking ceremony at 1012 W. 2nd Avenue in Belton to celebrate the expansion of the BISD Ag Barn. We have a large agricultural program in BISD, and

thanks to the community's approval of the 2022 Bond, we are adding capacity and opportunities for even more participation.

In closing, I want to share how thankful we are for your support of our students, staff, programs, schools, and district. Your engagement is truly enriching the lives of our students and staff, and we are deeply grateful for you. We also value your feedback. Please be on the lookout for surveys that will launch later this spring. A key way we engage the community is through these surveys. We had great participation last year and hope to have even higher levels of responses this year. BISD believes in continuous improvement, and the data collected in our surveys will inform our efforts to do better.
