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
MESSAGE FROM SUPERINTENDENT

Dear Parents,

As I shared with you last month, the new campus and district ratings from the Texas Education Agency's (TEA) still-changing accountability system are expected to be released at the end of this month. You will recall, this year the TEA changed both the test and the way letter grades are calculated for schools. The negative impact from TEA's planned changes will be seen statewide.

We believe Belton ISD will see an improvement in the passing rates on STAAR and End of Course assessments yet a decline in school ratings. While we will use the data from TEA to continuously improve, we also celebrate the fact that in Belton ISD, school is about far more than the STAAR test.

For that matter, we consider the idea of "being held accountable" to mean more than performance on one test, given on one day. In Belton ISD, we hold ourselves to a standard that goes beyond that one measure. The competencies outlined in the Belton ISD Journey



of a Graduate are an example of that standard because it was developed with the voice of the community.

We are also accountable to our students, parents, staff and community stakeholders through our five goals developed by our Board of Trustees. These District Goals address parent and community engagement, student learning and growth, employee support, culture, and stewardship of resources. The goals set clear direction for our school district. Each goal is tied to a Key Progress Measure (KPM) which represents the administration's most important work for the year as we pursue the goal. While the goals have remained constant year-to-year, the KPMs are updated annually. We publicly report on our progress toward goals throughout the year in our board meetings.



present during regular school hours at each campus.
