Big Red Community,

Summer is a busy time in Belton ISD. While you've been enjoying your summer vacation, our district's focus has been centered on



continuous improvement, professional learning and safety and security. Here are some of the highlights of our work providing campus safety:

Thanks to the <u>2022 Bond</u> approval, this summer every BISD campus is benefiting from important safety enhancements. Projects include the installation of shatter-resistant film, secure vestibules, campus building and door identification upgrades, keyless access, improved video systems and exterior lighting improvements.

These safety enhancements will begin this summer and will take several months to complete. Installation is expected to extend into the new school year. The scope of safety projects planned for each campus varies by need and will address new Texas Education Agency requirements for school security.

You may have seen the safety and accessibility upgrades at elementary and pre-school playgrounds which began during the final week of May. Additions include curbed fall protection at each campus playground along with increased sidewalk access to playscapes and swings. Additional playground equipment will be installed at the Belton Early Childhood School. We anticipate playgrounds to be complete before the start of the school year.
