Today, after commencement ceremonies for the class of 2022, we officially close out the 2021-2022 school year. I end the year — my second full one as superintendent of Belton ISD — with optimism and immense gratitude.

My optimism stems from the abundance of new programs and opportunities in the works for next year. When Belton New Tech becomes a standalone campus in the fall, students will have the chance to compete in class 3A athletics like tennis,

cross country, tennis and golf. They'll also be able to take Career & Technical Education courses in law and public safety, government and public administration, and drone operations. Our Lake Belton High School students will be able to immerse themselves in a new entrepreneurship program, IncubatorEDU, that will teach business startup skills with local entrepreneurs.
