Message from Superintendent



Today, I am grateful for the way our community came together this past week.

First, I want to thank the community partners who came alongside us over the past week and offered support. Everyone from the Belton and Temple police departments, local pastors and counselors, and central Texas school districts served as tremendous supports in our greatest time of need. Seeing our students back at BHS on Monday was a big step in the healing process for the school,

although we will grieve as a community for some time. I ask that thoughts and prayers continue for all those impacted during these difficult times.

On Saturday, voters in Belton ISDapproved both of the district's two bond propositions. This funding will build two new elementary schools — one in the north and one in the south — to accommodate enrollment growth. We'll also be able to update aging facilities, make safety and security improvements and address program inequities across the district, among other things.

This outcome is the result of a process that began with community voice through the work of the Bond Exploration Committee. It has concluded with community voice through the election process. We will work hard to be worthy of the community's trust by continuing our sound financial practices while also continuing to increase transparency as our bond program begins.

Saturday's election results were good news for our students and community but that is balanced by the grief we are experiencing. Thank you, Big Red Community, for supporting Belton High School and our district as a whole through these challenging times.
