## Message from Superintendent



Hello, Big Red Community,

I am coming to you with another reminder that Early Voting is underway. Election Day is Saturday, May 7. Polls are open 7 a.m.-7 p.m.

As you know, the two May 2022 bond propositions address:

- Accelerated growth of student enrollment;
- Aging facilities and changing needs;
- Ensuring that facilities don't limit educational opportunities for students
- Safety and security; and
- Technology

If approved by voters, these propositions will impact every Belton ISD school <u>without</u> <u>increasing the tax rate.</u> The Belton ISD tax rates have been lowered by 24 cents over the last five years. The Tax Appraisal District of Bell County sets the values of homes, not Belton ISD.

Since tax values have increased more than the 7.5 percent the district projected when modeling this bond, Belton ISD may be able to lower the debt tax rate. The Board of Trustees discussed this issue at a special meeting on Wednesday.


The 2022 Bond process began last fall with community voice through the work of the Bond Exploration Committee, and it will conclude this spring with community voice.
