## Message from Superintendent



Hello, Big Red Community!

In Belton ISD, we believe the learning experiences of our students are enhanced through the engagement of our community. We know there is a strong desire within our community for parents to be more informed and engaged in their child's education. For these reasons, I am excited to bring you some updates from our Board workshop on Monday.

On February 21, our Board of Trustees met and reviewed many of our existing community engagement initiatives. As the Team of 8, we discussed our student focus groups

about the Journey of a Graduate competencies, seeking student voice in the elementary school design process and the parent and community participation in the Bond Exploration Committee.

To provide exceptional learning experiences for each and every student, we believe our efforts must go further. The Board and I discussed several ways they would like to see the district increase stakeholder involvement.

Based on feedback, we are looking at ways to help parents review curriculum and weigh in on educational experiences for their children. One piece of our future plans is to make instructional materials more accessible online, so parents can be more aware and involved. Another example may be implementing processes to inform parents about the reading material their children are accessing through BISD libraries. We believe it's important for our schools to partner with parents so they can feel good about what their children are learning and reading.

Parents and positive adult role models can have a significant and powerful impact on students, especially those who may be struggling. That's why we plan to add parent input opportunities regarding student behavior expectations in addition to expanding on-campus volunteer opportunities for parents and community members.

The conversations with the Board at the workshop were exciting, and we are all in agreement that we must get more voices to inform our student-centered decisions.

We will share information about these opportunities in the weeks and months ahead as plans move forward.
