



Intra-District Transfer Guidelines
FDA Regulation

Adjusted 11/16/2020

Intra-District transfer students, and other students who do not reside in the attendance zone of the school at which they are enrolled, will have the following guidelines in place for participation in Belton ISD UIL athletic activities.

Intra-District Transfers

An intra-district transfer is defined as formal district approval to attend a Belton ISD high school that is outside of the students zoned campus.

- Students who apply for, and are granted an intra-district transfer will be eligible for varsity competition, if the transfer occurs at first available opportunity.
- Students who apply for, and are granted an intra-district transfer will be ineligible for varsity competition for one (1) calendar year from the date of approved transfer, if the transfer is not applied for at the first available opportunity to enter high school.
- Students are only eligible to participate in sub-varsity (JV, Freshman) practices and competitions. In the event the particular UIL activity does not have a sub-varsity, the Athletic Director will determine participation eligibility on a case-by-case basis.
- Once a student begins practice and/or the school year at the transfer school, if the student chooses to return back to their zoned campus, they will be ineligible for varsity competition for one (1) calendar year from the date of transfer back to their zoned campus.

Sibling Intra-District Transfer

- Students on a sibling transfer will be eligible for varsity competition, if the transfer occurs at the first available opportunity.
- If students on a sibling transfer wish to return to their home campus, they must do so at first opportunity to retain varsity eligibility.
- First opportunity is defined as immediately after the graduation of the elder sibling.
- Students who choose to return back to their zoned campus before the graduation of the eldest sibling, will be ineligible for varsity competition for one (1) calendar year.

New Tech High School

New Tech High School is a school of choice with no established attendance boundary.

- Students who enroll in New Tech High School, will be Varsity eligible, if the enrollment takes place at the first available opportunity to enter high school. If enrollment does not occur at the first available opportunity, the student will be ineligible for varsity competition for (1) calendar year.
- Once a student begins practice and/or the school year at New Tech, if the student chooses to return back to their zoned campus, they will be ineligible for varsity competition for (1) calendar year from the date of transfer back to their zoned campus.



Exceptions

Exceptions will be evaluated by the Athletic Director on a case by case basis.

Exceptions for New Tech - the New Tech class of 2025 returning to their home campus or BHS until July 11, 2022.
