How to format: alphabetical by author's last name (if no author, use title).

Reverse indent as shown—double space throughout

Using Easybib.com:

1. Choose the form of what you're citing (web site, book, article, lecture)
2. Add as much info as you have in the blank spaces provided by Easybib
3. Hit "Create Citation" at the bottom of the Easybib page
4. Copy and paste the beautiful, correctly formatted citation into your Works Cited
5. Adjust line spacing and order of citations so it looks like the sample above
