

VACCINATION COVERAGE for SCHOOL YEAR 2017-18

Northfield Middle/High School

Immunizations are required for enrollment in all Vermont schools to prevent the spread of infectious diseases. The Vermont Legislature passed a requirement in 2012, that all schools must make immunization coverage data for the student body available to the public. The information below identifies the percentage of students who have been fully vaccinated, and the percentage fully vaccinated for each individual vaccine. For purposes of comparison, the percentage of all Vermont students enrolled in kindergarten, 7th grade, and kindergarten through grade 12, who received the required vaccines is also presented. ^{vii} Fully Vaccinated – percentage of students meeting all vaccine and dose requirements
