This Week:

Math: We began learning about nickels, which made a lot of sense as we continued to practice counting by fives. We are also working very hard to practice solving word problem using both subtraction and addition.

Literacy: We are celebrating Dr Seuss' birthday (March 2nd)! We are reading many books written by the famous children's author which center around rhyme and a lot of decodable CVC words that we are now able to read! So far our favorite books are The Cat in the Hat, Green Eggs and Ham and One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish. Do you have any of these books at your house?
