Hill Scholarship of Alpha Delta Kappa	Applicants should be a High School graduate each June who plans a career in teacher education or a closely related field involving youth, has been accepted at an accredited college, needs financial aid, has exhibited qualities of leadership, has participated in school and community activities and has good moral character. This scholarship, a minimum of \$500, is payable at the beginning of the 2nd semester of the first year of college.

You may be eligible for one of these scholarships if one or more of the criteria below describes you and/or your future plans: Strong musical talent, an interest in pursuing social work, financial need, good citizenship, motivation to continue your educational training, majoring in Physical Education, Nursing, Pre-Med, Music, Art, Creative Writing, Drama, Literary Studies, or a related field of study.
