



3rd Grade Math and Science! (Week of Sept. 20th)

Math

Students have been using strategies to add 3 digit numbers. They have been using place value to help them break apart numbers to add. They also have been practicing their rounding skills to the nearest ten. We also have been finding time using word problems. Students are having fun trying to complete a 2 minute time test with multiplying by 2 and 3.

Science

Students have been investigating why ocean fossils can be found in the middle of Illinois or how whale bones were found in the Sahara Desert. They also read about the largest dinosaur that has been discovered and how the process worked. They were able to go on their own fossil dig in class to discover what animals were found in different layers of the earth.
