Did you know?

- Missing 10% of the school year (2 days per month) is almost the same as missing a month of school.
- Only 17% of students considered chronically absent in kindergarten and 1st grade were reading proficiently in 3rd grade....Compared to 64% of those students with good attendance (9 or fewer excused days per year)
- By 6th grade chronic absenteeism is a leading indicator of student drop out in high school.
- A student who misses 10 days is 25% less likely to enroll in college.

Cold weather is almost here! Please remember to send your child with:

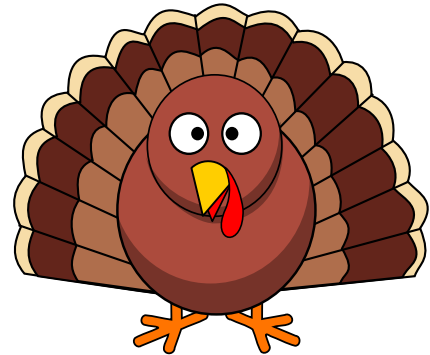
- Coats
