Dear Parents,

It is hard to believe that we are in December! We hope you and your family had a wonderful Thanksgiving and we wish you and your family a very happy and healthy holiday season.

I wanted to thank all our parents that participated in the fall parent-teacher conferences. Thank you for taking the time to meet with your child's teacher as we value our partnership to support your child. We encourage you to continue this communication with your child's teacher throughout the school year. It truly "takes a village!"

I wanted to share some information with you about our schoolwide character reward incentive program. Our character program rewards students for displaying good character, following the school rules, and being good citizens. Each month we focus on one of the following character pillars: Perseverance, Responsibility, Respect, Caring, Trustworthiness, Fairness, Cooperation, Honesty, and Citizenship.

All students can earn purple or gold tickets for displaying positive character traits. These tickets are then put into a container in their classroom. At the end of each month, three student names from each class are picked to choose from several rewards. The rewards change/rotate each month and may include soccer with Mrs. Sassine, lunch with Mrs. Fidura, games with Mr. Sidler, audiobooks/podcasts with Mrs. Lin, and lunch with a friend – just to name a few. In addition, each homeroom can earn feathers for their falcon posted outside their classroom. I am proud of all our students for working on displaying positive character traits each day!

Fostering positive character traits such as empathy and citizenship are of great importance for our school. Fifth grade students can become involved in our school and help the community by participating in student council. Our Student Council will be holding food drives and fundraisers throughout the year. Thank you to our 5th grade Student Council members and to our advisors, Mrs. Spielholz and Mrs. Nagle!

I wanted to share a few reminders as we move into these colder winter months. We always make every effort to send students outdoors for recess, as the weather permits. To that end, please pay careful attention to your child's attire to ensure it is appropriate and sufficiently comfortable for outdoor play. DELAYED OPENING SCHEDULE

During the winter months due to inclement weather, it may be necessary to have a delayed opening. If there is a scheduled delayed opening, school will start two hours later at 11:05 a.m. Students should report to their bus stop two hours later than their usual time. The students will have lunch on delayed opening days.

EARLY DISMISSAL

Occasionally, conditions exist which necessitate an early dismissal from school. It is always a good idea to have a plan in place with your child in the event of an unexpected early dismissal. MESSAGE FROM OUR SCHOOL NURSE, MRS. DEBELLIS

Happy winter Brookside families! Just a few friendly reminders:

- Watch the changing weather and dress your children in layers.
- Cold/Flu season is here; practice good handwashing & covering mouth/nose when sneezing and coughing.
- Always pack extra water and snacks.
- Keep your child home if they have a temperature of 100 degrees or higher, if they are coughing with excessive phlegm, or if they have diarrhea, nausea or vomiting.
- Keep your child home if they have symptoms of strep throat, red eyes, rashes, lice, or any other contagious illnesses.
- If your child has a fever of 100 degrees or higher, they cannot return to school until they are fever-free with no Tylenol or Advil for 24 hours.
- Always put your child's absence in Genesis or you will get the robocall/email/text automatically.
