

# What is The Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness Report? (CACR)?



Formerly known as the World's Best Workforce, CACR is a MN Statute developed in 2013 to ensure school districts enhance student achievement through teaching and learning supports. Districts develop a plan that addresses the following goals:

- → All children are ready for school.
- → All racial and economic achievement gaps between students are closed.
- → All students are ready for career and college.
- → All students graduate from high school.

# 2023 & 2024 Legislative Updates

May, 2024: the title *Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness* (CACR) replaced the title *World's Best Workforce.* 

May, 2023: The MN "Reading to Ensure Academic Development (READ)" Act replaced "All third-graders can read at grade level."

#### **READ Act Goal:**

- Every MN child reading at or above grade level every year, beginning in kindergarten,
- To support multilingual learners and students receiving special education services in achieving their individualized reading goals.

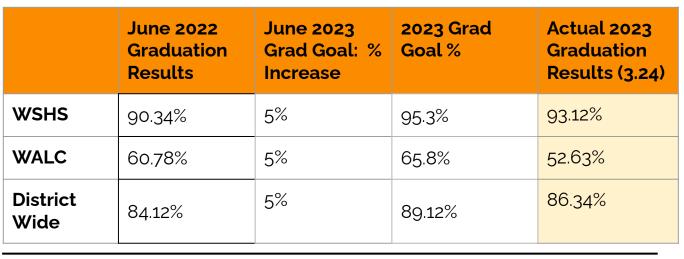
# Goal: All Students are Ready for Career and College
