

## **Meeting Minutes:**

**Vice Principal Claudia Rodriguez calls the meeting to order at 1:30 PM**

**Vice Principal Claudia Rodriguez began to explain the purpose of the site council and what the SPSA is. She explained that the main focus of the meeting would be to review the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) for the upcoming 2024/2025 school year.**

**Vice Principal Rodriguez provided a brief overview of the SPSA, emphasizing its role in setting goals for student performance and outlining the specific actions and strategies to support those goals.**

**Vice Principal Rodriguez then moved on to explain the district's Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) goal.**

**The district has set a goal to increase attendance and graduation rates by 6% for the 2024/2025 school year.**

**She discussed how these goals will impact the school's SPSA and outlined some of the strategies the school plans to implement in order to meet this goal, such as:**

**Here at Olympic we are building positive cultures to attempt to increase our attendance and graduation rate by 6%**

**Currently here at Olympic we have enrolled 261**

**We have 151 male students and 100 female students. Non binary**

**Vice Principal Rodriguez brought up WASC and how we will be having a visit in the Spring of 2025. Getting our WASC accreditation means that our diplomas are valid all over the country.**

**She included in the presentation Silver and Teal Pathways to support our students with very high anxiety.**

**We are looking forward to partnering with Big Picture Learning. They will be having our students shadow different District employees.**

**Goal 4: Focal Scholars - Case management for at risk seniors. Delta Bay Impact Program.
