What to complete ahead of time?

Students and one parent need a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) to sign the FAFSA.

You are encouraged to complete this step ahead of time on:

studentaid.gov

What do you need for the FAFSA?

- Social Security Numbers for the student and parent (it's important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA!)
- Driver's License number if you have one
- Your Alien Registration number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- **2023** federal tax information or **2023** tax returns including IRS W-2 information, for both the student and parents
- Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans noneducation benefits, for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
- Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate but not including the home in which you live; and business and farm assets for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
