PRESCHOOL & PREKINDERGARTEN

- We are committed to preparing your child for success by supporting the intellectual, emotional and social development needs of young children in a positive and nurturing environment.
- We provide a play-based developmentally appropriate curriculum that is Four Star Parent Aware rated to enhance your child's learning.
- Priority is given to Richfield school district residents who meet eligibility requirements set by the Minnesota Department of Education.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN OUR PROGRAMS

- Small group activities where the teacher works with 3-5 students at a time on specific skills.
- Large group activities where students learn to interact with the teacher and peers in a classroom setting.
- Outside/gym time for large muscle development.
- Play! It is the work of children. During playtime, children learn academics, social skills, self-confidence, problem-solving, communication skills and more.

PRESCHOOL FOR 3s

Students must be 3 years old on or before September 1 of the year in which they attend Preschool for 3s.

Morning and afternoon sections available at the Central Education Center:

- 3 days - Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays
- 2 days - Tuesdays and Thursdays

PREKINDERGARTEN FOR 4s

Students must be 4 years old on or before September 1 of the year in which they attend Prekindergarten for 4s.

Transportation is available. Community school boundaries apply.

Classes meet for 2.5 hours a day Monday through Friday at:

- Centennial Elementary
- Richfield STEM Elementary
- Sheridan Hills Elementary
- The Central Education Center

DUAL LANGUAGE OPTIONS FOR 4s

Morning and afternoon sections are available for these five-day-a-week classes.

- Richfield Dual Language School (90% Spanish, 10% English)
- The Central Education Center (50% Spanish, 50% English)
