- Research-proven methods are used to teach languages at a high-level while instructing academic content.

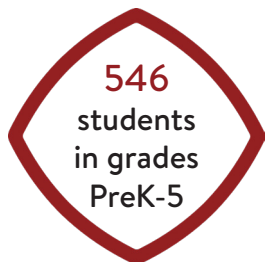
