Some information about the Tower Garden at the Elementary School supplied by Ms. Graf.

"I received the Tower Garden when I was awarded the Grow With Us Grant from NY Agriculture in the Classroom. We have three tower gardens in the elementary school. They are aeroponic, hydroponic ways to grow plants indoors as a way of extending the growing season all year long. The students have learned the lifecycle of plants, and will be creating videos of how to plant and care for the tower garden. We intend to use our tower garden to discuss healthy nutrition such as fruits and vegetables. We use it as a springboard to talk about taking healthy snacks to school. It gives our students an authentic, hands-on opportunity to see, touch, taste, smell healthy foods."
