


TURKEY TROT FUN!

2025-2026 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Enrollment begins January 14 for students who will be NEW to Waggoner.

Current students <u>DO NOT</u> need to re-enroll.

Visit Kyrene's <u>Online Registration</u> to enroll your child(ren). Online registration records will be flagged as an Open Enrollment application for students live outside of the Waggoner's boundaries. Open Enrollment must be approved before registration is considered final.

Documents needed to complete registration:

Families have the option to upload these documents through the online portal or drop them off in person at our front office.

- Certified Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Proof of Residency (current utility bill, lease agreement, mortgage document, etc.)
- Government-issued photo I.D.

WHEN TO KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME FROM SCHOOL

In an effort to keep illness out of the school, we ask that you keep your child home if they display any of the following symptoms.

AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLASSES

Before and after school youth enrichment classes for children ages kindergarten through middle school are held on campuses throughout the Kyrene School District and enrollment is open to students throughout the Valley.

ENRICHMENT REGISTRATION

All registrations accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. No registrations will be accepted at the school. Online registrations will be accepted until 9:00am on the day class begins. Phone registrations will be accepted until 9:00am on the day class begins. Late registrations will be accepted from the day after class begins until 9:00am on the day the second class session meets. Registrations will not be accepted after the second class session has met. Class confirmation will be sent to the email you have set-up in your account. Parents are responsible for keeping their account information up-to-date.

Just a reminder to please have your child check the Lost & Found before winter break!



TAX CREDIT INFORMATION

The deadline to make a 2024 tax credit donation to a school or student activity of your choice is April 15, 2025. Under the Arizona tax credit program, tax payers can direct a portion of their state income tax to a specific program such as sports or other extra-curricular activity, or to a school. The maximum tax-credit for an individual is \$200 and for a married couple, \$400.



STUDENT A.M. DROP-OFF & P.M. CAR PICK-UP

A.M. STUDENT DROP-OFF ZONE:

Parents, please remember that the first bell for school rings at 7:25am. In order to beat the 7:25-7:30 rush and ensure that your child arrives on the playground to be picked up by his/her teacher on time, please consider dropping your child off earlier between 7:10-7:20. In doing so, we think that you will find the drop off area to less congested and quicker to use. Here are a few very important reminders that will help make this system continue to be safe and successful.

- Please pull your car forward in the parking lot until you reach the Drop-off zone.
- Once you are in the Drop-off zone, **pull your car as far forward as possible** before your child exits.
- Please have your child exit as quickly as possible on the curb side to keep traffic flowing.
- Adults, please stay in your car at all times.

P.M. STUDENT CAR PICK-UP:

Our **supervised** system takes place directly in front of the school at the pick-up and drop-off lane. Most of you use this area, and we thank you for your patience and conscientiousness in following our procedures.

Unfortunately, there are a couple of places where **unsupervised** student drop-off and pick-up sometimes occur. The first is the west parking lot in front of Waggoner and Kyrene Middle school. This parking lot is **NOT** a designated pick-up and drop-off area thus we do not have duty personnel in that location. That area is to be used as a parking lot only, meaning that you are more than welcome to park in a designated spot and either walk your child onto campus (morning) or walk and meet him/her in front of the school (afternoon). If you want to drop-off or pick-up your child using your vehicle you will need to get in the designated pick-up and drop-off lane in front of the school.

The second **unsupervised** area being used is along S. Lakeshore Drive. For those of you who aren't aware, it is illegal to park on Lakeshore Drive between the hours of 7:00am and 3:00pm. **Not only is it illegal but in many cases, it causes an obstruction for our crossing guard who is trying to safely cross children.** Parents have been observed doing many unsafe things in that area, such a u turns in the middle of the street and letting their child get in and out of the car on the street side. We discourage the use of Lakeshore for picking-up and dropping-off students and want you to know that you are doing so at your own risk. This area is **unsupervised** and is not a designated pick-up and drop-off location. Also, as a reminder, please focus on entering and exiting campus safely, and limit your use of cell phones during this time.
