

NOTE: The principal may remove a student to an interim alternative educational setting (IAES) for not more than 45 instructional days without regard to whether the behavior is determined to be a manifestation of the student's disability. <u>CLICK HERE TO LEARN MORE</u>.

Within the same year, removals totaling <u>more than</u> 10 consecutive days - or 10 cumulative days that were determined by the school to be a pattern - this is called a "Disciplinary Change of Placement" and a manifestation determination conference is required.

511 IAC 7-44-5

MANIFESTATION DETERMINATION

#1: Was the conduct in question caused by or did it have a direct and substantial relationship to the student's disability? #2: Was the conduct in question the direct result of the public agency's failure to implement the student's IEP?

YES to either #1 OR #2: (1) A Functional Behavior Analysis (FBA) must be conducted or in existence and a Behavior Improvement Plan (BIP) must be implemented, reviewed and modified as necessary to address behavior. (2) **RETURN student to the placement from which they were removed,** UNLESS parents and public agency agree to change of placement as part of the modification of BIP.

YES to to #2: The school must also take immediate steps to remedy those deficiencies.

NO: Discipline can be applied the same as any student. However, student must: (1) Continue to participate in gen-ed curriculum (in another setting); (2) Progress toward meeting goals in IEP; (3) Receive an FBA and BIP as well as modifications that are designed to address behavior to prevent recurring.
