- ◆ July 12th ACT not offered in NYS
- ◆ Visit college campuses.
- ◆ Research other post high school options.
- ◆ Continue working on college essay(s).
- ◆ Begin summer reading.
- ◆ Try to complete your community service hours.

## CHECKLIST FOR GRADE 11

### AUGUST:

- ◆ August 26th—Tryouts begin for the 2024 fall sports season for all Varsity and JV sports (9-12th grades). Register on line with Family ID.
- ◆ Check student schedule for correct course selections. Any confusion, email your School Counselor.

### SEPTEMBER

- ◆ September 5th - Attend High School Open House at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ September 11th—Attend Financial Aid College Workshop 6:00 pm in the MS/HS Performing Arts Center. Parents/guardians and students welcome.
- ◆ Remind student this year is critical for college admissions.
- ◆ September 27—Last day to add a class.

### OCTOBER

- ◆ Sign-up for extra-curricular activities.
- ◆ October 11th—Watch for first quarter progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ October 16th—Juniors take PSAT.

### NOVEMBER

- ◆ November 8th - **Deadline** to register for the December 14th ACT.

- ◆ November 8th –Last day to drop a class.
- ◆ November 12th - College and Career Prep class starts.
- ◆ November 15th - Check first quarter report card. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/ counselor.
- ◆ November 22nd - **Deadline** to register for the December 7th SAT.
- ◆ Sign up for winter sports.

### JANUARY

- ◆ January 3rd –**Deadline** to register for the February 8th ACT.
- ◆ January 9th—Accommodations meeting for CSE/504 students taking the SAT/ACT at 6:30.
- ◆ January 9th -**Attend Mandatory College Planning Night** in the PAC at 7:00 p.m.
- ◆ Students should attend review sessions for mid-term/Regents exams offered by teachers.
- ◆ January 21st - 24th - Mid-term/Regents exams.
- ◆ Apply for college summer programs.

### FEBRUARY

- ◆ February 7th -Review second quarter report card. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ Decide which standardized test you might take and how to prepare for it.
- ◆ February 8th –ACT.
- ◆ February 21st - **Deadline** to register for the March 8th SAT
- ◆ February 28th—**Deadline** to register for April 5th ACT.
- ◆ Mandatory: Schedule an appointment for an individual/family Post High School Planning conference with your counselor.
- ◆ Select courses for senior year.
- ◆ Apply for college summer programs.
- ◆ Visit colleges during winter break.

### MARCH

- ◆ March 8th - SAT.
- ◆ March 21st - Review third quarter progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ Sign-up for spring sports.
- ◆ Apply for college summer programs.
- ◆ Attend college fairs and open houses.

### APRIL

- ◆ April 5th - ACT
- ◆ April 18th- **Deadline** to register for May 3rd SAT.
- ◆ Mid-April—College and Career Prep—Part 2 begins.

### APRIL(cont.)

- ◆ April 18th - Review third quarter report card. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/ counselor.
- ◆ Visit colleges during spring break.
- ◆ Attend college fairs and open houses.

### MAY

- ◆ May 9th – **Deadline** to register for June 14th ACT.
- ◆ May 3rd SAT.
- ◆ Mid-May —AP exams for those students taking AP courses.
- ◆ May 22nd - **Deadline** to register for June 7th SAT.
- ◆ May 23rd - Review final progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- ◆ Urge student to begin reviewing for finals/ Regents.
- ◆ Apply for summer jobs or internships

### JUNE

- ◆ June 7th - SAT.
- ◆ June 14th—ACT.
- ◆ Students should attend review sessions for finals/Regents exams offered by teachers.
- ◆ June 4, 10, 17, 18, 20, 23, 24 and 25 - Regents/ final exams.
- ◆ Mid-June – Virtual Lunch & Learn for Juniors and families—noon.
- ◆ Review final report card and check for accuracy.
