## ANNUAL DISTRICT MEETING AND ELECTION May 17, 2016

The Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote for the Shelter Island Union Free School District, Town of Shelter Island, County of Suffolk, State of New York was held at the school in said district on May 17, 2016 (Affidavit of Publication is attached to these minutes.)

At 12:00 pm, prevailing time, Tuesday, May 17, 2016, the Annual District Meeting and Election of the Shelter Island Union Free School District, Town of Shelter Island, County of Suffolk, State of New York, was called to order by the Board of Education Vice-President, Linda Eklund.

Vice-President Eklund administered the Constitutional Oath of Office to the District Clerk, Inspectors of Election and Poll Clerks: Jacqueline Dunning, Angela Corbett, Phyllis Wallace, Shirley Ferrer, Jean Dickerson, Lois Corbett, Lew Corbett, BettiAnn Morritt, and Thomas Morritt.

The polls were declared officially opened at 12:00 pm, prevailing time and announced that they would remain open until 9:00 pm, prevailing time, for the purpose of voting by ballot for the Proposed Annual District Budget as presented for the fiscal year 2016-2017 and to elect two (2) Members of the Board of Education, for three (3) year terms commencing on July 1, 2016 thru June 30, 2019.

Proposition 1: Shall the Shelter Island Union Free School District Budget in the amount of \$10,966,854 the fiscal year 2016-2017 be approved as proposed and the requisite portion thereof raised by taxation on the taxable property of the district?

Adoption of this budget requires a tax levy increase of 5.92% which exceeds the statutory tax levy increase limit of 3.75% for this school fiscal year and therefore exceeds the state tax cap and must be approved by sixty percent of the qualified voters present
