BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Board of Education hereby approves Patricia Kreppein, as Mathematics Teacher, effective September 1, 2016, at \$54,742, Step 1 BA+15 of 2015-2016 teacher salary scale, with a four (4) year probationary period through September 1, 2020, in the tenure area of Mathematics 7-12.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: Ms. Kelly must receive three (3) annual APPR composite ratings of Effective or Highly Effective, in at least three (3) of the preceding four (4) years and cannot have an APPR composite rating of Ineffective in the last year of her probationary appointment to be granted or considered for tenure.
