BUDGET VOTE

PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Education appropriate funds not to exceed the amount of \$582,346 for the 2016 budget year, which sum represents an increase of \$19,693 from the 2015 budget amount, for the general use, maintenance and financing of the Shelter Island Public Library and its facilities, which sum shall be raised by tax on the taxable property within the Shelter Island Union Free School District?

The polls were officially closed by Jo-Ann Robotti at 4:00 p.m.
