Dr. Hynes explained what the Plant Operations budget included. Michael Dunning, Maintenance Crew Chief spoke about an increase in the equipment line caused by the need for a new district truck and new scoreboards in the gymnasium.

When speaking about the Athletics Program, Dr. Hynes mentioned that Cross Country has been added to the budget.

At this time, Dr. Hynes introduced Ms. Kathleen Minder, Business Manager who presented the Cafeteria Budget. Ms. Minder spoke about the cafeteria expenses, revenue, profit/loss, as well ideas for improving the cafeteria.
