ANNUAL DISTRICT MEETING AND ELECTION May 20, 2014

The Annual District Meeting and Budget Vote for the Shelter Island Union Free School District, Town of Shelter Island, County of Suffolk, State of New York was held at the school in said district on May 20, 2014 (Affidavit of Publication is attached to these minutes.)

At 12:00 pm, prevailing time, Tuesday, May 20, 2014, the Annual District Meeting and Election of the Shelter Island Union Free School District, Town of Shelter Island, County of Suffolk, State of New York, was called to order by the Board of Education Vice-President, Thomas Graffagnino.

Vice-President Graffagnino administered the Constitutional Oath of Office to the District Clerk, Inspectors of Election and Poll Clerks: Jacqueline Dunning, Angela Corbett, Phyllis Wallace, Shirley Ferrer, Lois Corbett, Jean Dickerson, Lew Corbett, BettiAnn Morritt, and Thomas Morritt.

The polls were declared officially opened at 12:00 pm, prevailing time and announced that they would remain open until 9:00 pm, prevailing time, for the purpose of voting by machine for the Proposed Annual District Budget as presented for the fiscal year 2014-2015 and to elect three (3) Members of the Board of Education, for three (3) year terms commencing on July 1, 2014 thru June 30, 2017.

Proposition 1: Shall the Shelter Island Union Free School District Budget in the amount of \$10,472,814 the fiscal year 2014-2015 be approved as proposed and the requisite portion thereof raised by taxation on the taxable property of the district?

Proposition 2: Shall the Board of Education be hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$381,000 representing monies from the capital reserve fund established on May 16, 2006 for the following purposes: installation of acid neutralization tank, installation of flooring/rugs, installation of new fire alarm system, and brick repointing and crack repair, including all ancillary and incidental work required to be performed in connection with said projects?

Since the funds to be expended hereunder are from the Capital Reserve Fund, approval of this proposition will not require a tax levy upon the real property of the district.
