BUDGET VOTE

The Special District meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 27, 2012 by Joann Robotti, for the purpose of voting on the Library budget for 2012. Joann Robotti administered the Constitutional Oath of Office to the District Clerk, and Inspectors of Election: Jacqueline Dunning, Angela Corbett, Phyllis Wallace, Marion Gleason, and Shirley Ferrer. The polls were officially opened for voting on the following proposition. Secret paper ballots were used for voting. In addition to Joann Robotti and Denise DiPaolo, no other person was in attendance.

PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Education appropriate funds not to exceed the amount of \$510,327 for the 2013 budget year, which sum represents an increase of \$28,886 from the 2012 budget amount, for the general use, maintenance and financing of the Shelter Island Public Library and its facilities, which sum shall be raised by tax on the taxable property within the Shelter Island Union Free School District?

The polls were officially closed by Archer Brown at 4:00 p.m.

The voting was as follows:

The library proposition was declared approved.
