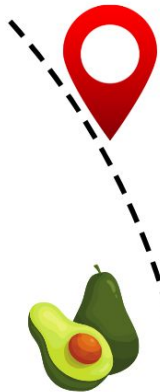

3 Ready for a pit stop and some delicious food on the go? Stop in New Jersey, the Diner Capital of the World, with over 600 diners statewide.



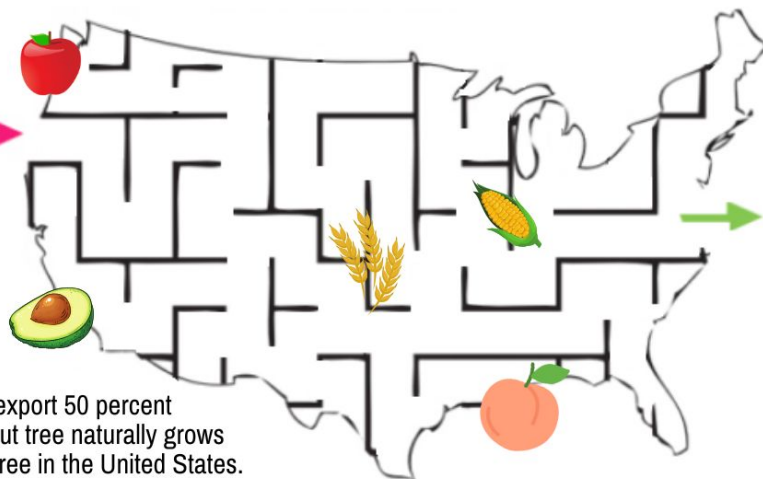
