# THE PINGRY SCHOOL POTTERSVILLE ARTS RESIDENCY

## ABOUT THE RESIDENCY

Pingry is a K-12, co-ed, independent day school with campuses in Basking Ridge, Pottersville, and Short Hills, NJ. Rooted in relationships, guided by student-written Honor Code, our community includes more than 1,100 students from more than 90 communities.

The summer residency for visual and performing artists and writers is an ideal opportunity for those seeking time and space to create work in a tranquil setting with a cohort of like minded creatives. Once a working farm, then a boarding school for girls, and now Pingry's satellite campus, the 83-acre grounds are set amidst rolling hills with expansive views and wilderness to explore. With spaces to work indoors and outdoors, artists can continue their bodies of work or create work in response to the setting.

Visual art studios for drawing, painting, dark room photography, and clayworking (wheels/no kiln), as well as theater, rehearsal spaces, and an array of quiet writing spaces will be available to create, write, practice, and perform. Participants will stay in a 7-bedroom farmhouse, each with their own private bedroom.



# RESIDENCY DETAILS



**WHO SHOULD APPLY:** Adult (21+) individual artists, performers, and writers at all stages of their career, who are seeking a week-long studio immersion to work independently while enjoying a community cohort.

**CAPACITY:** 7 residential participants/7 day participants.

**LOCATION:** The Pingry School, Pottersville Campus, Pottersville, NJ.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Residents will stay together in cohort in the Brook House, a 7 bedroom/6 bath farmhouse on campus. Each participant will have a private bedroom.

**DATES:** Monday, July 8 - Sunday, July 14, 2024

We ask for full participation in this immersive experience by staying uninterrupted at the residency (9 a.m. - 7 p.m. for day participants.)

**CHECK-IN:** July 8, 12 p.m. - 4 p.m. (4 p.m. greeting, tour, and dinner reception)

**CLOSING RECEPTION + FAREWELL DINNER:** July 13, 6 p.m. - 9 p.m.

**CHECK-OUT:** July 14 by 12 p.m.



**AMENITIES:** In addition the spaces above, participants will have access to the library, fitness center, tennis courts, walking trails, and more, all surrounded by farms and bordering the picturesque Hacklebarney State Park. All spaces are equipped with A/C and wifi. Basic art materials are stocked in the studios.

**COLLABORATION:** Independent work, as well as opportunities to engage with each other in facilitated discussions designed to encourage feedback sharing and cultivate community will take place. Evening meals and lively conversation will be a nightly ritual. This residency will give you time and space to realize your creative ideas in a supportive cohort. A closing reception will provide residents a platform to share their work with a wider audience.
