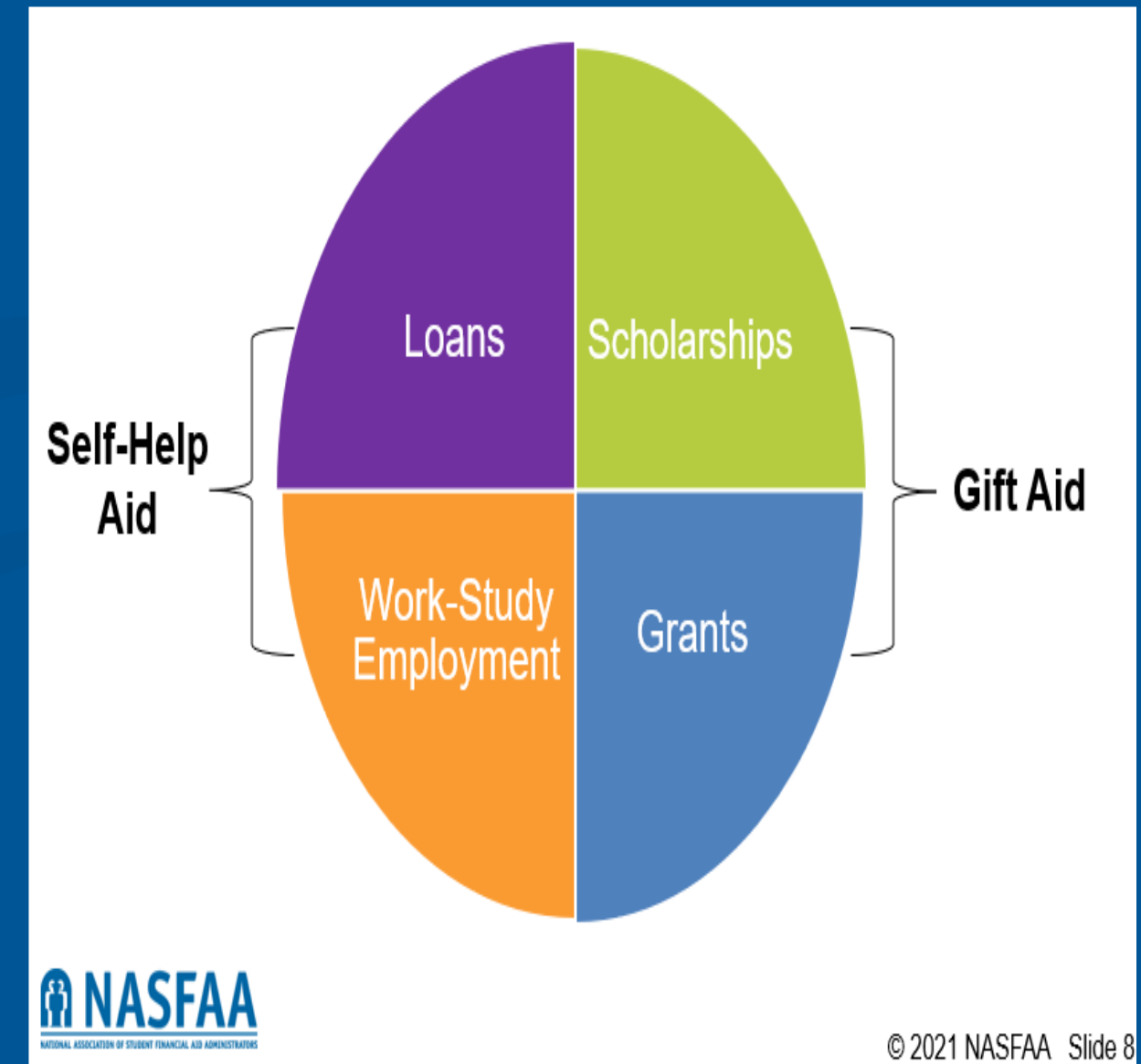

Documents needed when applying for any Financial Aid!

Social Security Numbers for student and contributor(s)

Date of Birth for student and contributor(s)

Marital status of contributor(s) that provides the greatest financial support

Income taxes (federal and state) for the appropriate year – **2023**, for student and contributor(s).

Citizenship status (citizen or green card holder)

Drivers license information for student and parent(s) if applicable.

Username and passwords for applications: They must be created.

FAFSA = FSAID – student and contributor

HESC = HESC pin – student

SAP

Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) in college

GPA Requirement. Cumulative 2.0

Pace of Completion: 67% of attempted credits

Why does SAP Matter:

Financial Aid

How to Maintain SAP:

Keep at least a 2.0 GPA

PARENT(S) WITHOUT SSN(S)

CAN NOW APPLY!!!

Issue:

When the 2024–25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form first became available, a technical issue prevented contributors without a Social Security number (SSN) from starting or accessing the form. This issue has been resolved. Students are now able to submit a fully completed FAFSA form that includes contributor information.

Resolution:

Beginning with the 2024-25 FAFSA, all applicants and contributors must utilize an FSA ID for application completion.

To comply with the revised FSA ID requirements, a new process has been introduced, allowing individuals without an SSN to acquire an FSA ID, streamlining the completion and signing of the FAFSA application.
