

# Golf Study Guide

1. Name the three different clubs – (1) woods (2) irons (3) putter
2. What do you yell when you hit the ball toward someone? “FORE”
3. Every time you hit the ball it is call a “stroke”  
You add up the strokes and that is what you get on the hole for your score
4. If you swing and miss the ball it counts as a stroke on your score
5. PAR – is the standard score for a hole. A hole can be a par 3, par 4, or par 5  
For you to get a par, you need to make the ball in the hole on that many strokes or hits
6. You cannot talk while someone is hitting the golf ball.
7. The higher the number on a club, the higher the ball will go – but the ball will not go as far. The lower the number on a club, the lower the ball will go – but the ball sill go far.
8. The score of one under par on a whole is called a “BIRDIE”  
Example: If you score 3 strokes on a par 4 hole
9. There are 18 holes on a regular golf course.
