

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Special Education at Eastchester High School provides a continuum of services to meet the needs of students with disabilities. The majority of special education students must meet the higher state standards and graduation requirements. Our program strives to prepare students for the rigor of these new mandates. This goal is accomplished through providing opportunities for inclusive education and a continuum of support services. The comprehensive service delivery model includes regular classes, resource room, co-teaching, labs, workshops, testing modifications, and program modifications. Additionally, “safety nets” are in place in the event a student does not meet the requirements of a Regents diploma in any given subject.



Eastchester High School also offers a range of programs for students whose needs cannot be met through the inclusive model. These students, focusing on academic & social skills, will typically graduate with a New York State Alternative Assessment Diploma. In addition, the high school will be offering a supplementary Career Development and Occupational Studies Commencement Credential.
