Greetings Camp Hill Community,



# INCLEMENT WEATHER & FLEXIBLE INSTRUCTION DAYS

Should an occurrence of inclement weather occur during the 2024-2025 school year, the first 2 days will operate as Snow Days (school closed/no instruction). Any following days will be Flexible Instruction Days (FID) and the District will operate remotely (at home instruction through Schoology). Notice will be made the evening prior or at the earliest notice possible. Communication will be broadcasted through Blackboard Messenger by the Superintendent's Office and through Schoology by each school's administration. The District will not exceed 2 snow days and 5 FIDs throughout the academic year. Should additional inclement weather closures be needed they will be added as a make-up day on June 4th 2025 and beyond.
