CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

Middle school is a time of transition, and the curriculum for grades 6-8 is designed to support both academic and social emotional growth. Students receive instruction in English language arts, social studies, mathematics, science, integrated technology, art, music, physical education and a world language. Students also participate in HEART, a daily period for social-emotional skills development. Select students may earn high school credit by successfully completing Integrated Math I & II.
