Objectives

- Provide professional development opportunities to address literacy, (comprehension, writing), and mathematics problem solving.
- All teachers will instruct using performance- based standards which include the content standard (SWBAT) and performance-based (IOT) activity.
- Teachers will start class with an ACT bell ringer on Monday, Wednesday,

- Reduce student chronic absenteeism.
- Reduce the number of days each teacher misses throughout the school year.
- Provide incentives/recognition for students who attend school regularly who has perfect (no absences/no checkouts) and / or outstanding attendance.

- Students will work on pathways as determined by STAR Renaissance reading and math diagnostic, ACT Cert, and Jumpstart in small group and individually,

- Attendance officer files petition with courts at seventh unexcused absence.
- Administration tracks all absences and conference with identified teachers.
- Administration develops, implement, and monitors performance improvement plan for teachers with several absences.
- Students celebrated at academic celebrations each nine weeks.
- Tangible awards provided such as gift cards, etc.
- Recognition each nine weeks at academic celebration
- Tangible / Intangible gifts and awards provided such as gift cards, duty free lunch, etc.
