Mission: At North Riverside Elementary, we work together to ENSURE that every student and every staff member experiences SUCCESS.

This compact outlines how parents, school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and how the school and parents will build and develop a partnership to help children achieve the State's high standards.

School Responsibilities:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables students to meet the State's academic standards.
2. We will use research-based instructional practices, and Title I funds to support effective learning experiences.
3. We will provide differentiated instruction and interventions such as iStation and DreamBox during "What I Need" (or WIN time) to meet the diverse needs of all students.
4. Hold parent-teacher conferences twice a year, during which the compact will be discussed as it relates to each student's academic achievement.
5. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Progress will be shared every nine weeks through report cards, as well as updates on Class Dojo and weekly emails for consistent communication.
6. Provide parents with reasonable access to staff. Parents may request meetings with teachers or administration through email, phone, or Class Dojo.
7. Share regular communication in both English and Spanish, including newsletters, Class Dojo updates, and information on school events.
8. Create a welcoming and respectful school environment for parents and families. We will host Parent Engagement Nights focused on academic support strategies, such as literacy and math workshops.

Parent Responsibilities:

1. Ensure my child attends school daily, arrives on time, and completes homework assignments.
2. Read with my child daily and encourage them to read independently.
3. Engage with Class Dojo to monitor my child's behavior and academic updates.
4. Use the NWEA MAP Family Report to track my child's progress and collaborate with teachers to set academic goals.
5. Participate in parent-teacher conferences and stay informed about my child's educational progress.
6. Attend school events and workshops that support my child's learning, including Parent Engagement Nights.
7. Volunteer in classroom activities or participate in school committees like the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA).
8. Maintain open communication with my child's teacher and respond promptly to school communications.
9. Notify the school of any changes in contact information or address so that communication channels remain open.

Student Responsibilities:

1. Come to school every day, ready to learn, and complete all homework assignments.
 2. Follow classroom expectations and participate actively in learning activities.
 3. Take responsibility for my own learning by asking for help when needed and setting personal academic goals.
 4. Follow school rules and participate in the Class Dojo, our Positive Behaviors and Interventions and Supports (or PBIS system), specifically focusing on following directions the first time and demonstrating respect toward my classmates and teachers.
 5. Contribute to a positive school culture by showing kindness and teamwork.
 6. Take pride in my progress and celebrate academic achievements.
