Message from the Superintendent



As we celebrate the benefits of our recent Capital Projects, we are thrilled to introduce the next step in our journey to provide outstanding resources for students and the greater Manchester-Shortsville community. The Forward Together, Pride for Tomorrow capital improvement project reflects a commitment to high-quality, equitable education and a promise to enhance our facilities without increasing taxes.

Through the dedicated work of our Capital Project Committee and input from stakeholders, we have developed a \$19,950,000 proposal, which the Board of Education has proudly approved. Of that current proposal, \$4,340,000 will come from a District reserve fund, with state aid covering 89% of approved costs. This project will address key areas of need across our campus while building on our shared vision for the future.

This project represents more than just updates to our campus—it's an investment in our students, staff, and community. Improved facilities, elevate educational spaces and demonstrate a unified commitment to ensuring Red Jacket is a place where students thrive.



Capital Project Timeline



The timeline for our capital project is set to unfold over the next few years, beginning with a crucial vote on **January 15th, 2025,** from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. in the **Red Jacket Auditorium foyer**. If the project is approved, construction will begin in July 2026, with an anticipated completion date in August 2028. This timeline ensures a thoughtful, strategic approach to development, balancing community input and careful planning at every stage.

Capital Project Cost



The total cost of the capital project is estimated at \$19,950,000, with **NO ADDITIONAL TAX INCREASE** to residents. 89% of the project will be funded through New York State Aid, while the remaining portion will be covered by the district's capital reserves. This funding plan ensures that the project can move forward without placing an additional financial burden on taxpayers.
