The supports and interventions we have put in place over the past five years allows our district to readily meet the needs of our students. All buildings will continue to implement already established interventions that are aimed to build relationships and connection, address regulation of emotions, and build skills to cope with the stress of everyday life. Due to the nature of the current COVID-19 pandemic, these interventions will be provided and implemented more frequently and more intensely to ensure that all of our staff and students are well and ready to learn. ### **The following interventions are available:**

- Direct or supporting role in supporting students in adapting to COVID-19 precautions such as social distancing, wearing a mask, and other sanitizing measures necessary.
- A recently secured Mental Health Intervention grant from KSDE will allow for referrals and mental health services to occur and be facilitated within the school setting if the student and parent consent.
- Utilize screening data to determine students who may benefit from increased supports such as daily check in's, small group skill building, and possibly even an individualized plan to meet behavioral needs.
- Zones of Regulation education and resources, as well as locations that will be sanitized after each use for students to access for a calming environment to utilize regulation skills.
- Guidance lessons for appropriate grade-levels, social emotional curriculum, and school counseling services.
