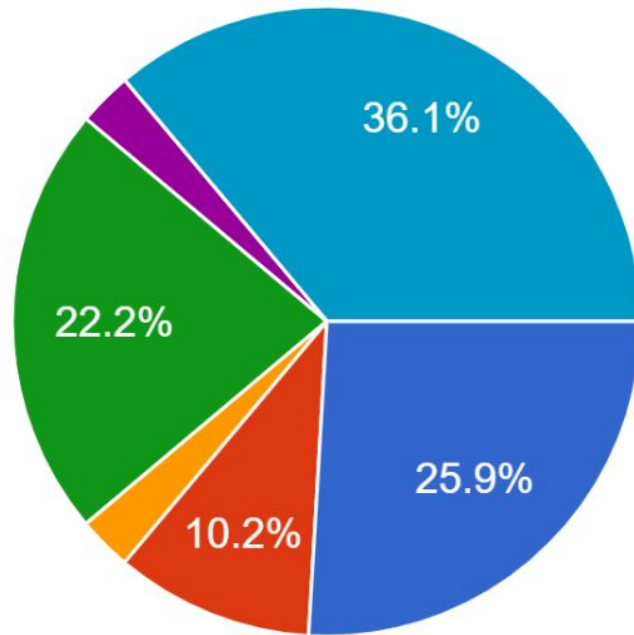

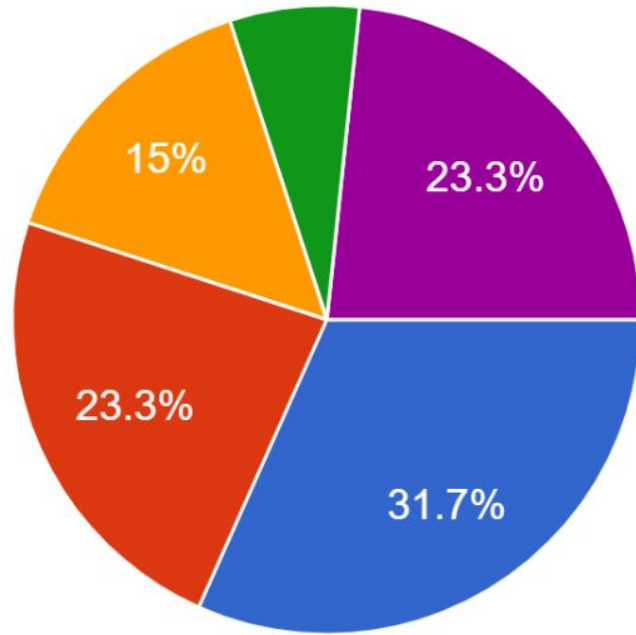

Academic Honors & Specializations



How do I qualify?

- 3.5 GPA or better after Semester 1 grades are posted.
- Also need to have earned 8 credits of advanced courses. Part of the 8 credits will include your Semester 2 grades.
- To be a Valedictorian or Salutatorian you **must** fill out and qualify for the Academic Honors Diploma.
- If you have a 3.5 GPA or better but don't have 8 credits of advanced courses, that's okay. You may still qualify for the Honors Certificate!
- Many of our students will qualify for the Specialization Certificate. For example: if you've done 4 years of band, choir, AG, business or construction. There are lots of options for specialization. In order to qualify you must have a 3.5 GPA in that sequence.

How do I apply for an Academic Honor or Specialization?



- Application process opens after the Semester 1 grades have been entered.
- The Academic Honor/Specialization application form will be available at the Registrar's office.
- A transcript is needed to complete the Honor/Specialization application. Transcripts will be mailed with your Semester 1 report card and can also be found by logging into your Student Vue Account.
- Applications will be available Wednesday, January 29th, 2025 and they are due Friday, February 21st, 2025 by 1:00pm.
 - **NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE DEADLINE!!!**
- You must apply to receive honors!

10 most common errors on Job Fair paperwork...

1. No signature on the cover letter or job application (or a computer generated one)
2. Misspelled words
3. Capitalization (All proper nouns...specific person, place, organization, thing)
4. Sloppy handwriting on job application or written in pencil
5. Commas (extras placed in areas not needed)
6. Missing info on references (contact information)
7. "Qualities" that aren't good qualities (examples: tall, pretty, muscular, etc)
8. Long resumes (should not be more than one page)
9. Poorly written letters of recommendation (handwritten, written by friends or family members, short/no info)
10. "Blank" spots on resume (example: says "city" instead of "Lebanon")

The job fair assignment, including attending the job fair, is a Graduation requirement!

If you do not turn in your paperwork by Thursday, December 5th at 3pm, you will be required to do the alternate assignment.

If you do not show up for the job fair, you will be required to do the alternate assignment.

The Job Fair is on Tuesday, December 17th. We start in the auditorium and then move to the gym for interviews.

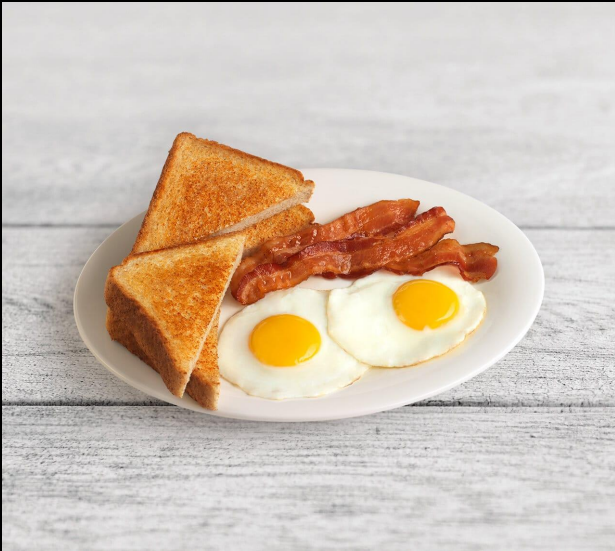
You should arrive to the auditorium by 7:45am.

Posture and body language:

- ☐ Be Professional
- ☐ Sit up straight
- ☐ Avoid fidgety, nervous behaviors. *Example: Playing with your hair or clothing, tapping a pencil, etc.*
- ☐ Maintain eye contact
- ☐ Smile

Be prepared to answer questions:

- ☐ Be Confident
- ☐ Show motivation
- ☐ Talk about your skills, experience, and education
 - o Skills: Mathematics, computer skills, and/writing skills
 - o Related coursework: automotive, art, or speech classes
 - o Work Ethic: being a team player and being able to follow rules, being on time
 - o Extra-curricular Activities: sports teams, artistic, or academic clubs
 - o Volunteer Experience
- ☐ Practice at home
- ☐ Give clear examples of your strengths

Career Questions:

- ☐ What types of positions are available in this industry?
- ☐ What experience or skills are desired in this field?
- ☐ How do people generally get the required qualifications?
- ☐ What occupations would prepare someone for this career?
- ☐ Is there a preferred or required education level for this kind of job?
- ☐ What is the salary range of this career?
- ☐ Are there many opportunities for advancement in this career?
- ☐ What is the career outlook for this occupation?
- ☐ Is there a lot of competition for jobs in this field?
- ☐ Can you think of any drawbacks or disadvantages to this career choice?
- ☐ What kinds of other careers could someone in this career transition into?
- ☐ What would a typical day on the job in this field be like?
- ☐ What kinds of problems do you solve from day to day in this career?
- ☐ What kinds of decisions are you responsible for making?
- ☐ Why did you choose this career?

**What will you
be evaluated on
during your
interview?**

- Appearance
 - Did you come dressed for an interview? Are you presentable?
- Preparedness
 - Is your paperwork complete and does it look professional?
- Handshake/Greeting
 - Did you greet the interviewer? Did you introduce yourself?
- Eye contact
 - Did you hold appropriate eye contact throughout the interview?
- Communication
 - Did you communicate your answers well? Did you ask appropriate questions?
- Confidence
 - Did you show confidence in your appearance and answers?
- Body Language
 - Did you have appropriate facial expressions? Did you sit up straight and not fidget in your seat? Did you appear relaxed?
- Attitude
 - Did you use appropriate manners? Was your language appropriate? Was your humor appropriate?

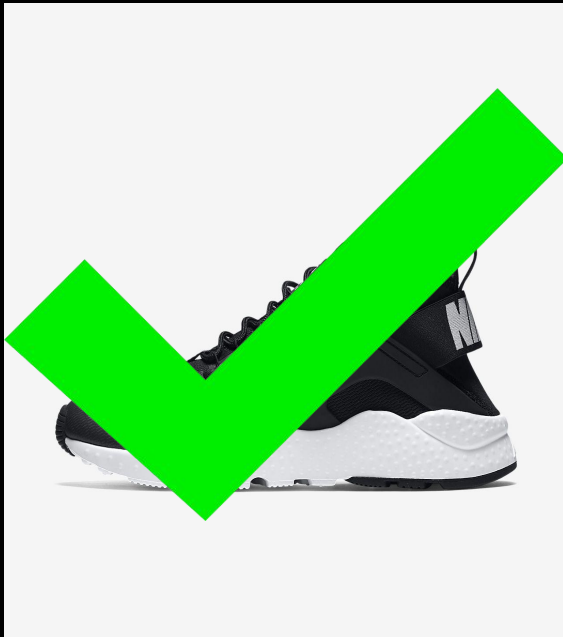
















The Golden Rule of Interview Attire
