# A Note from the Principal

### Dear Fairview High School Parents and Families,

As we approach the holiday season, I want to take a moment to express my gratitude for your continued support of our school community. It has been a wonderful first semester, and we look forward to finishing strong and continuing our journey together in the new year.

I would like to invite you to join us this Thursday, December 12th, for two important opportunities to engage with us and share your thoughts. We will be hosting Coffee with the Principal from 10:00 to

11:00 AM in the College and Career Center (CCC), followed by our School Accountability

Committee (SAC) meeting from 5:30 to 6:30 PM, also in the CCC. During these sessions, we will review the Parent Dashboard for Fairview High School, seeking your feedback and suggestions for improvement. Your insights are invaluable as we work together to create the best environment for our students.

Additionally, we will reflect on the first semester and discuss an important new initiative for the upcoming year: our new Cell Phone JRCT/Policy. While we have just begun our conversations about how this policy will be implemented, I want to share some initial information that may be helpful to you.

1. Classroom Policy: There will be no major changes to the current classroom expectations. Instructional policies will remain the same: All Cell Phones, Earbuds, & PTDs are silent and out of sight during class periods. All Cell Phones, Earbuds, & PTDs are to remain in the classroom and not brought to restroom. Cell Phones, Earbuds, & PTDs should remain in backpack or in teacher designated area while student is away from classroom.













- 2. Implementation in January: Generally, students will be asked to keep their cell phones in lockers, backpacks, cars, or designated classroom holders. The primary change will be cell phone usage outside of teacher-directed, instructional purposes.
- 3. Support for Students: We are committed to a progressive, supportive, and relational approach to this transition. We need your help in encouraging students to keep their phones away during passing periods, free periods, and lunch. I encourage you to remind them of the importance of socializing and connecting with their peers in person, building strong relationships within our school community.

Lastly, I encourage you to complete our <u>Fairview Feedback Form</u> with any questions or concerns you may have. We value your input as we continue to grow and improve together.

Thank you for your partnership, and I wish you all a joyful and restful holiday season. We look forward to seeing you on Thursday!



- Introduce a key initiative for the upcoming year: our new <u>Cell Phone JRCT/Policy</u> and its early implementation plans.




## **Get Involved with Impact on Education Before 2024 Ends!**


