ACCLAIMED HOLLYWOOD FILM EDITOR TO PRESENT ARTIST TALKS FOR LOCAL STUDENTS

From his beginnings filming class projects in high school to working on independent films all the way up to work on blockbusters like Marvel’s “The Avengers” and “Captain American: Civil War,” film editor Jeffrey Ford has experienced it all in Hollywood and he is set to share his wisdom with local students next week, including a session open to the public at 3 p.m. next Wednesday at Trollwood Performing Arts School.

Local high school and college students interested in film and performance have a unique opportunity to learn from acclaimed film editor Jeffrey Ford on Tuesday and Wednesday, as he shares insights from a career that has seen him edit some of the most popular films of all time.

Ford will present artist talks for two FPS high schools, South High School and the Virtual Academy, as well as Minnesota State University Moorhead and Concordia College. The talks will be structured in a question-and-answer format, with students able to ask Ford about any topic they want to learn more about.

The public is invited to attend the session for Virtual Academy students at 3 p.m. Wednesday at Trollwood Performing Arts School.

Ford is best-known for editing Marvel films such as “The Avengers,” “Iron Man 3,” “Captain America: Civil War,” and “Spider-Man: No Way Home,” as well as “Shattered Glass” and “Public Enemies.” Most recently, he edited Marvel’s “Werewolf by Night” and is working on the upcoming Netflix film “The Electric State.”
