Attendance Matters when scholars are in school to hear the information Student Achievement increases. As of 11-8-24 19% of scholars are chronically absent meaning they are missing more than 10% of number of days we have been in school. Currently 19% of scholars have 4 or more absences as of 11-8-24. Below is a breakdown of the number of scholars in each grade that are chronically absent in blue out of total number of scholars in the grade level in red. It is imperative that your scholar is in school daily and if you are having issues with getting your scholar to school reach out to the main office. In addition, if your scholar is one of the chronically absent students identified they are on track to be **RETAINED!**

We expect scholars to be in school 95% of the time as you can see from the chart no grade level is meeting the 95% average daily attendance. Parents we must do better at getting scholars in school daily. Scholars missing school tremendously effects their grades and their ability to move on to the next grade level. Let's help our scholars by getting them to school daily.

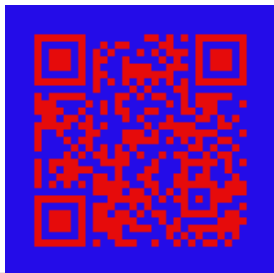

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

When a student misses **2** days a month..

They will miss **20 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **30 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **1 YEAR** of school by graduation.

When a student misses **4** days a month..

They will miss **40 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **120 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **2 YEARS** of school by graduation.

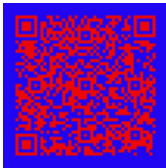
UYA Uniform Policy
