#### **WRAPAROUND CARE**

You will be aware from previous information sent out that we have a new wraparound care (WAC) provider starting here at the academy after the Christmas break. This provision will be for the children of Dudley Infant Academy and All Saints CE Junior Academy. This includes a walking bus service from All Saints to Dudley. We are pleased to let you know that the new provider will be Fireflies Childcare. Information about what Fireflies will be offering is detailed below. Could we please encourage you to read this if you are thinking of utilising the WAC provision. If you would like to find out more information regarding Fireflies Childcare, you can visit their website at www.fireflieschildcare.co.uk.

As we progress through this term, further details will be provided to parents and carers in relation to Fireflies wraparound care. In the meantime, Fireflies are keen to gauge levels of interest of the sessions on offer and therefore a survey link will be sent out by the academy via Parentmail.

Fireflies' childcare limited is excited to announce they will be opening at Dudley Infant Academy!

At Fireflies childcare, we understand that parents need reliable and trustworthy childcare, and that children need a fun and enjoyable experience. Our club ethos is to create a friendly, relaxed, and safe environment where kids can be confident to express their individuality.

Breakfast Club will run from 7.30am until school starts. It costs £6.50 per session, per child.

Breakfast is an informal time for children to come into school to socialise, eat and enjoy quiet tabletop activities before they start their day.

After School Club will be divided into two sessions; Twilight from end of school until 5pm (£10) Or after school; from end of school until 6pm (£14).

The twilight session starts with snack time; there will be a choice of fruit for the children. After that, the time consists of small tabletop activities, such as colouring, loom bands, toys, sewing, board games, puzzles etc., or outdoor play. There will be a topic themed craft for the children should they choose.

After school club includes a cooked supper at 5pm. This consists of a small, healthy meal from a weekly menu. Including options such as beans on toast, pasta, pizza etc. A full menu is available.

We will also have an exotic taste section of supper time, where the children will be encouraged to try something, they haven't had before – such as exotic fruits and vegetables.
