BOARD KEY OPERATIONAL GOALS

The board commits itself to the following goals:

- 1. Ensure that the well-being of students, staff, and the entire school community is always the guiding principle when shaping any policy, keeping their best interests at the heart of every decision.
- 2. Formulate policies that accurately address the educational needs of the school community while fostering effective two-way communication to support and stimulate the learning process.
- 3. Focus the board's efforts on policy-making and data-driven decisions to remove barriers and successfully implement the school corporation's strategic goals.
- 4. Conduct board business transparently by openly sharing information, actively soliciting stakeholder input, and encouraging meaningful participation in the board's decision-making process.
