SYA scholarship opportunities include merit and need-based awards. In order to be considered, applicants must submit all materials by February 7, 2025.

Halsey Fund Scholar

One full year student will be awarded full tuition along with a stipend for round-trip airfare from Logan airport to the SYA campus.

Alvarez Global Scholars

These scholarships are awarded to outstanding public school students. The average award covers more than 50% of tuition. Applicants must attend a public school and qualify for financial aid.

Merit Scholarships

One applicant from each SYA campus will be selected to receive either a \$30,000 scholarship for the full year or 15,000 for the semester.

Legacy Scholarships

Applicants must be a child or sibling of an SYA Graduate. Legacy students can be awarded up to \$10,000 for the year and \$5,000 for the semester.

1964 Scholarships

These scholarships are awarded to a limited number of exceptional students. Awards vary in amount and recipients can receive up to \$15,000.
