

Life in 6th Grade



- School runs from 8:45 a.m. 3:15 p.m.
- Buses arrive 15-20 minutes prior to start
- Optional breakfast is served everyday in the cafeteria
- Students have an Advisory period to start their day
- No cell phone use during school hours
- Each student has their own locker with a built in lock/combination



Life in 6th Grade



- Students use Schoology (courses, gradebook, etc.)
- They are taught how to stay organized
- Students socialize with friends in grade level common areas
- 6th grade only lunch period
- Be on the lookout for clubs and activities after school

New Immunizations for Middle School

- MCV Vaccine (Meningococcal)
- Tdap Vaccine (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
 Both are required before entering 7th grade, or a legal <u>Conscientious Exemption</u> on file (click link for form).

Send in a copy of your child's vaccine records when new vaccines are given. All elementary immunizations records carry through to Middle School and there is no need to resubmit.



Physical Exam Form

- Your child needs to complete a Physical Exam before being eligible to enroll in a sport.
- Physical Exams are good for 3 years for sports eligibility purposes.
- Print a copy of the Physical Exam form with the link below and bring to your next appointment.
